Registration	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> All competitors must be registered with an International Judo Federation (IJF) federation. Proof of identity (eg passport/drivers licence - must contain a photo) must be shown at weigh in together with proof of national registration. 					
Weigh In	Saturday 5 March at the venue Unofficial: TBC Official: TBC Judoka who fail to make weight in their designated weight category shall be disqualified from that category, but these judoka may have their name entered into the appropriate category for their weight on payment of an administration weight change fee (amount TBC)
