NEW RULE Any new rules introduced by the IJF, approved by the Technical Directorate and incorporate in the JNZ sporting code will be applied.

VETERANS Where there are insufficient numbers in any weight or age category those weight or age groups may be amended with the approval of the participants.

OPENS **Restricted Kyu Opens:** for Senior Women and Senior Men 5th Kyu to 2nd Kyu
Open entries will be allowed **on the day** from players who have already entered a weight category,

- There are no arm-locks allowed in the Cadet divisions, however;
- Those **Cadets entering Junior Men/Women and Senior Men/Women Divisions** will encounter arm-locks in these divisions.

ONLINE ENTRIES ONLY: Entries can only be completed online at the JudoNZ website <http://www.judonz.org>

VIP and Club Representative Form must be returned to the Tournament Controller.

2021 REGISTRATIONS*** The online entry system will not allow entries to be completed for those whose JNZ registration expiry falls on, or before the day of the event. Please ensure membership registration is current.

Weigh in:

There will be a concurrent unofficial and official weigh in from 0730 until 0830. This means that during this time your weight can be recorded as "official" if you so wish. Official weigh in will then commence at 0830 for those players who have not already recorded a weight.

Weigh-in Clothing: Contestants are required to weigh in wearing no more than underwear, tee-shirt and Judo trousers. All contestants must have an official weight recorded at the official weigh-in.

NOTE: Children and Cadets MUST weigh in with minimum of underwear – no stripping down further – 100 grams tolerance for the underwear is allowed.

Order: Saturday commences heavy to light weight categories: Cadets, Veterans, Juniors then Seniors

Sunday heavy to light weight categories: children 7 to 10 yr ----- then 11 to 14yr .

NB – This order may be changed without notice – DO NOT leave the competition area on the day without confirming first

WEIGHT CHANGE PENALTY FEE: Contestants who fail to make the weight entered on the official entry form, may enter the appropriate category on payment of a **penalty fee** as above. **This penalty must be paid at the weigh-in.** The penalty will not apply where the change of weight category is officially notified by **Wednesday 19th May**

WITHDRAWALS: Before the tournament please advise Entry Steward as soon as possible. At the latest, before the weigh-in commences.

During the tournament withdrawals will be accepted only from Club Coaches, or the Official Club Representative.

REFUND OF ENTRY FEES: written application (stating the reason for the withdrawal) must be made within one (1) month of the end of the Tournament to the Tournament Controller.

ORDER OF CONTESTS: In each division, heavy to light weights then Opens.

GOLDEN SCORE applies for all categories. Additional time will be open ended for all divisions.

CONDITIONS:

- 1 IJF Contest Rules, as modified by the NZJF Sporting Code, will apply
- 2 Cadets are allowed to execute Shimewaza (strangles) but **NOT** Kansetsuwaza (armlocks)
- 3 Each female contestant is required to wear a long plain white T-shirt under her judogi.
- 4 **The use of a blue gi instead of a blue belt is optional.**

Draw System for categories with 5 entries: A five pool draw will be used.

PRESENTATIONS: Each competitor who has won a medal must receive the medal personally. Trophies for Canterbury Champions in the Open Categories are awarded only to Canterbury registered judoka.

DAN EXAMINATION POINTS: Are available in JW, SW, JM, SM and Veterans Divisions, provided the number of entries and standard are acceptable to the National Technical Director.

CLUBS AND PARENTS are responsible for the control of their members and supporters. .

CANTEEN: No canteen is available. Tournament Officials who have advised the Organisers of their attendance prior to the event and work sufficient hours will be provided with a light lunch.
